## ROLF LUFT AWARD 2023

The Rolf Luft Foundation invites nominations for the 2023 Rolf Luft Award in Endocrinology, Diabetes and Metabolism.

The Prize ceremony will take place at Nobel Forum, Karolinska Institutet, where the awardee will receive the Rolf Luft Medal, a Diploma and a price sum followed by a lecture by the awardee on his/her research to an audience of basic and clinical researchers and clinicians.

The nomination should include a CV, a list of the nominee’s ten most important publications and a short description of the nominee’s contributions to science and health in Endocrinology, Diabetes or Metabolism (no more than 200 words). The deadline for the nomination is December 15, 2022.
