**Abstract submission deadline is August 31<sup>st</sup>.**

Abstract selections are peer reviewed by the scientific committee and acceptance is based on the quality of scientific content. Some abstracts will be selected for a short oral presentation as part of the program. Abstracts will be available through the [conference website](#).

### Instructions for abstract:

- An abstract should be a maximum one A4 page. Include title, authors, KI department, affiliation to Region Stockholm, background, methods, results and conclusions. Figures and/or tables can be included. Use Arial, font size 12.
- Use paragraph breaks between title, author & address, and abstract body.
- Write in a way so that researchers outside your research field can understand.
- Submit your abstract as a pdf-file to [collaboration-in-science-medh@ki.se](mailto:collaboration-in-science-medh@ki.se) Write “Abstract Collaboration in Science 2024” in the subject line.
- Upon submission select which of the following topics your abstract belongs to:
  - **Aging and neuroscience**
  - **Cancer**
  - **Care Sciences**
  - **Cardiovascular disease**
  - **Imaging**
  - **Inflammation and infections**
  - **Liver, pancreas and Kidney**
  - **Metabolism**
  - **Regenerative medicine**
  - **Women & child**
  - **Other**
- Abstracts will be selected for oral or poster presentation.
- The six best abstracts will be selected for awards of 20 000 kr each. Awards can for example be used as a travel grant.
- **Abstracts deadline is August 31<sup>st</sup> 2024.** Remember to also register for the conference!
